FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY DIVISION 2 [GRADE 1 AND 2]

Reopening: The two years of the COVID pandemic deprived children of the joy of school life. Their excitement to meet teachers and friends they had only seen online was palpable. Following the new education policy of 2020, emphasizing Foundation Literacy and Numeracy with the concept of mother teachers, classes 1 and 2 commenced on June 1st, 2022. The first-day attendance percentage was 84%, with 104 students in Grade 1, 132 students in Grade 2, totaling 236 students. The FLN section boasts 12 teachers in 9 divisions. Education focuses on foundational literacy and numeracy, activity-based and experiential learning, collaboration, and art-integrated learning, fostering holistic development. The school adopts 360-degree holistic assessment with 4 domains and 3 competency goals: health and well-being, effective communication, and involved learners.

General Body Meeting: The academic year commenced with the first General Body meeting held on 31st May 2022 at 3:00 p.m. via Google Meet. Additionally, the inaugural staff meeting with the staff secretary occurred on the same day at 9:30 a.m. Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) were conducted to discuss mid-term assessment marks and overall performance on 16/7/2022, 17/9/2022, 8/10/2022, and 04/04/2023.

Assessments : Throughout the academic year, MP International School conducted a series of comprehensive assessments to track students' progress and evaluate their learning journey. The assessments included:

Pre-midterm assessment: Held from 24th August 2022 to 1st September 2022.

Midterm assessment: Conducted between 20th October 2022 and 27th October 2022.

Post-midterm assessment: Administered from 23rd January 2023 to 31st January 2023.

Summative assessment: Held from 20th March 2023 to 30th March 2023.

REPORT -SECTION 3-5 [FLN 2]

Rejoicing Return:After two years of lockdown and COVID crisis, MP International School reopened its doors for Grade 3, 4, and 5 students on June 1, 2022. Prior to the reopening, a crucial General Body meeting, led by the Principal, was held to address the parents and students. The meeting emphasized the need to bridge the learning gap caused by the pandemic. With 14 classes and a total of 355 students, Section 3-5 is the most populous section of the school, marking the transition from Foundational Literacy and Numeracy stage. Parents, students, and teachers eagerly embraced the return to the familiar routine of school days.

The corridors of MP International School were abuzz with excitement as students eagerly returned to their physical school after a prolonged period of two years of homeschooling. Grade 3, 4, and 5 classes were organized into 5, 5, and 4 divisions, respectively. In each grade, the A division was designated for students who needed additional support to bridge the learning gap caused by the pandemic. Teachers were prepared to provide the necessary hand-holding and guidance to help students get back on

track. The school community was determined to make this academic year a successful and fulfilling one.
